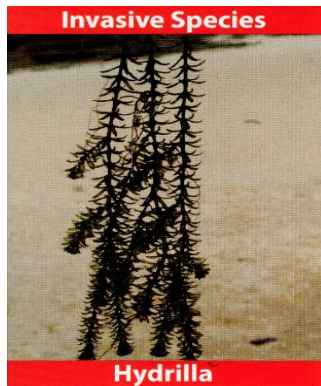


Invasive Weeds

Know what they look like. Report them if you see them.



HYDRILLA

Small, serrated leaves.

Spread by cuttings that sink and root.

Looks like plants used in aquariums.



EURASIAN WATERMILFOIL

Already found in Simonton Lake!

Extremely fast growing.

Feathery leaves with tiny flowers above water surface.

Grows to form mat on water surface.

Spread by cuttings that sink and root.



CURLY-LEAF PONDWEED

Three-inch leaves that are reddish green.

Grows to form mat on water surface.

Spread by cuttings that sink and root.



Starry stonewort forms dense mats on the surface of the lake

Identify by star-shaped flower.
